Ancient Egypt

Before beginning our history topic on the study of Ancient Egyptians, the children will explore the geography of modern Egypt: its location in the world, its climate and key physical features. We will then move on to learn about the Ancient Egyptian civilisation and explore how they lived.



English

The Spring term Master Reader texts will be **'Mr Penguin and the Tomb of Doom'** and **'Marcy and the Riddle of the Sphinx'**



The children will write character descriptions, stories set in historical settings, persuasive writing, suspense writing and instructions.

Maths

The children will continue to use the **compact column methods** for addition and subtraction of 3-digit numbers and will apply the **2,3,4,5 & 10 times table** multiplication and division facts to problem solving.

They will identify and find unit and non-unit fractions of amounts and will continue to explore shape, space and measures.

Science



We will study two topics this term. In the first half of term, our topic is **light and dark**. We learn about reflection, shadows and the movement of the Sun. In the second half of term, we will be investigating different **forces**, including magnets.

We will be learning about Muslim's beliefs about Allah and the Prophet Muhammed in Spring 1. During Spring 2, we will look at the key messages of Easter.
