Phonics Screening will take place the week commencing **Monday 8th June**. The best way to support your child is through listening to them **read as often as possible** and sign your child's record book at least twice a week. Home learning will be **phonics screening practice**. Each week there will be a new QR code, in the reading record, linked to words to practise blending.

On Safari

Geography: The children will compare the **physical and human features** of the **Kenya** with familiar places in the United Kingdom.

Victorian Seaside

History: The children will learn about the birth of the Victorian seaside holiday. They will learn about travel, clothes and the activities they enjoyed.
