



# Year 4 Summer Term 2026



## Welcome back

We have another busy term ahead of us with many exciting things including our trip to Ufton Court. We are looking forward to meeting you again at the Parent Drop In later this term and showing you our work at the End of Year assembly.

## Maths

We will be continuing to practise our multiplication tables daily in preparation for the Multiplication Tables Check later this term. We have focussed on number work a great deal and this term we will look at how we can apply these skills. We will start by continuing our work on decimals and then apply that to money. Over recent years we have found the children are less familiar with real money so we would appreciate you showing them real coins and if possible having the opportunity to use them to help understand that the coins have a value. We will also be learning about time and shape.

## Anglo Saxons and Vikings

This term our topic will have a history focus and we will be learning all about the Anglo Saxons and Vikings. We will be finding out what life was like for them and why they settled in Britain.



## Spanish

We will be continuing to learn Spanish. We are learning how to say and write the date. After half term we will be learning vocabulary to explain what is in the classroom



## Reminders

Please can you ensure your child has their Reading Record book in school every day especially as these contain all their login details.

It is really important that you keep practising your times tables, there are lots of online games you can use to help you.

**RE:** We shall be exploring all about Sikhism and in particular how the Gurus influence how a Sikh lives their lives and the importance of the Gurdwara.

**PSHE:** We will be learning about how we can ourselves healthy and then later in the term we will looking at the growing and changing unit.

**Music:** We'll continue to follow the Charanga music scheme.

## English

In English, we will be writing in a range of genres influenced by our reading of our Master Reader text – Winter of the Wolves. We will be writing about the Anglo Saxons coming to Britain in the style of a newspaper report. After the half term we will be using Viking Voyagers to inspire our writing.

## We Love Reading!

Reading records need to be signed by an adult regularly, ideally 3 times a week and these will be regularly checked by classroom staff. Try to read the recommended books as well. Guided Reading will be done as a whole class as part of the Master Reader lessons. We are happy for you to read books from home. Please make sure you still record these in your reading records and bring it to school every day.

**Science:** This term we will be learning about the different states of matter and the differences between solids, liquids and gases.
